



Gerrards Cross Conservation Volunteers

The volunteers meet on the third Saturday of each month (except August and December) and work on the Common.

We remove any trees which seem to present a danger of falling across a path, or cut up those which have fallen, unless they are so big as to require a chainsaw. We cut back brambles and clear undergrowth where they are encroaching on paths and open spaces. We tackle the incursive holly which has taken hold of many parts of the Common.

Usually about 8 to 10 of us are present and this means that a satisfying amount of work can be done in a morning and the results are clearly visible.

If you would like to join in, please meet outside the hut on East Common (next to Colston Court) where we keep our tools at 9.30 on the third Saturday of the month. We stop for coffee and biscuits mid morning and you will be made most welcome.
