## Gerrards Cross Conservation Volunteers

Gerrards Cross Conservation Volunteers have met 10 times in the past year to work on the Commons.

We have cleared scrubby undergrowth from areas of both West Common and East Common which has noticeably improved their visual appearance for people walking or driving along adjacent roads. We have also cleared holly which grows densely within the wooded area of the Commons, to create open spaces and to give light and space for more worthwhile species to grow.

Another regular task has been to keep New Pond free of logs, litter and other floating debris.

The volunteers are led by Bill Collins (tel: 882959) and we meet on the third Saturday of each month, except December, at 9.30 by the wooden hut next to Colston Court on East Common where we keep our tools and equipment. We work until about 12.30 with a break for refreshments, usually at the Parish Office.

There are usually about 8-10 volunteers working and we would be pleased if you would join us. More information is available from the Parish Office (888018) or Bill Collins, as above.
