Thames Valley Police have carried out an EVA (Environmental Visual Audit) on the Fulmer Drive/Beeches footpath. There is extensive graffiti and poor street lighting. The Committee agreed to visit and consider if additional lighting would assist.

Clerk to write to all four residents and ask them to remove all the Graffiti also say the PC is considering additional lighting and what are their thoughts.

Beat Barrow – SBDC are still working to upgrade the sweeping on the Packhorse Road and ask if there is somewhere to store the Beat Barrow.

The Committee agreed that the standard of sweeping has improved and thought Tesco may be able to assist in this matter.

Not in Our Neighbourhood – Both JW and CB went out with the Police today assisting with their Parking day, and both felt that the Police had insufficient resources to do this effectively. It proved only that the Police should not be used to tackle Parking enforcement and it should be decriminalised. CB to try and find out if there is any progress in this matter.

Dominic Grieve MP has written regarding a letter from a local school boy saying he does not feel safe using his bike to go to school. Reply was approved by the Committee.
