2 **Actions were reviewed from the meeting on the 1st March 2010.**
Clerk to get lamp post 292 foliage cutting back.
Possible change to LED Clerk to ascertain cost of change and the difference of the efficiency.

3 **Lighting**

4 **Highways**
The broken post by New Pond is still not repaired. CB to take a photograph and send to TfB.
1/4/10 M&S customer services are looking into the problem of their lorries parking with their wheels on the pavement.
Barclays Bank – asked to get the damaged Gas Box repaired. Copy to SBDC David Gilmour.
Jackson Howes – Packhorse Road the Council has reason to suspect that there are rats in the building. Clerk to report rats to SBDC.
Alan Nedus 6 Station Approach – asked to clear up cigarette ends and litter from outside their offices.

VAS Packhorse Road – The Committee discussed if there should be a further survey to say what effect the sign has had. The Parish Council has had nothing but good feedback for residents and the committee felt that a further survey was not required.

The Committee agreed to re-review the locations for the Windsor Road VAS signs and then to progress the installation.

CCTV – The Committee considered if the cost of the camera that is used for at least 90% ANPR should be paid by the Council. It was agreed to pay only 75% of the bill for 2009/10 to assist the Council in possibly funding an additional CCTV camera within 4 years.

BCC Application for Modification Order Over the Misbourne from A413 to Slade Oak Lane.

This is an application to make this a Restricted Byway. The local residents association say that any persons/cyclists that have been seen are always advised that this route is a private road and they have no right of way. The Council holds no information to support the application to modify this order.
